



EXPEDITION ACCOUNT BOOKS

These books of account, maintained by someone named Daniel Lowman, date back to 1926 when it appears very specific bank accounts were established in order to fund a series of international travels, mostly based out of Bangkok, for a variable number of men.

- 1926: Jiangxi Province, China
- 1927: Hungary
- 1927: Tunguska Crater, Siberia, Russia
- 1929: Vietnam
- 1930: South Dakota, United States
- 1931: Pompeii, Italy
- 1932: Mt. Kailash, Tibet
- 1933: Nan Madol, Pohnpei, Micronesia
- 1934: Axum, Ethiopia
- 1935: Brixton, England

Little can be determined about the specifics of the expeditions from these records of account, but there are references in several places to “full reports” being forwarded to “Savitree’s Library”.
