Most esteemed sir,

The taxation circumstances of the Sirikhan clan are not to be confused with similar resistance to official communiqués arising from imperially-aligned factions. As you can see detailed below, this is an outstanding issue which predates the glorious revolution of the Khana Ratsadon. I am uncertain as to the exact cause of this failure of proper revenue census, but

**1925.** Proper revenue census reports are filed in the name of Governor Kongdech Sirikhan. They report a total population on the island of 37, including 19 members of the hereditary clan. (FILE ID PK78-KK2565)

**1928.** A clarification regarding the passing of workers from the island is requested. Unfortunately, the original communiqués have been either misplaced or destroyed, and it is therefore uncertain what the exact nature of the discrepancy may have been. (LOG PK89-6788)

**1930.** Proper revenue census reports are not filed. An official request is sent in Sept 1930. (FILE ID PK78-KK3022)

**1931.** A large payment is filed, sufficient to cover a population three times larger than that reported in 1925. (LOG PK79-A6543)

**1932.** Despite the recorded payment of the previous year, apparently proper revenue census papers have not been filed. An official request is sent by my predecessor in the Royal Revenue Department asking for a proper census of the island to be made. (FILE ID PK79-KK3209)

It appears that the change of government later in that year caused the matter to be dropped.
